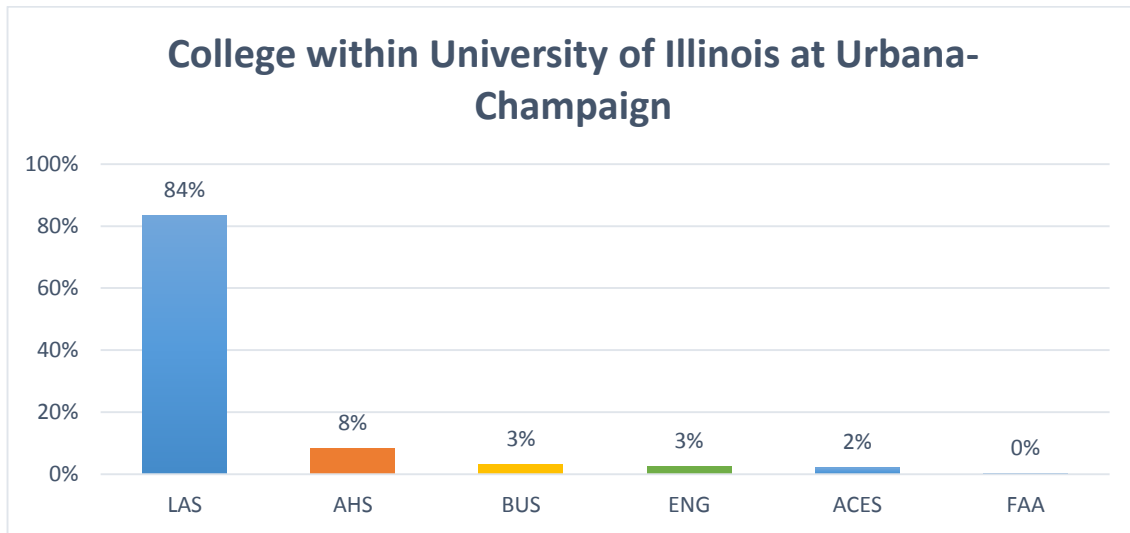

Undergraduate College & Major

Medical school hopefuls come from a variety of colleges within the University of Illinois and from distinct majors.

College at Illinois

The 387 applicants to medical schools represented seven of Illinois' colleges and schools: College of Agricultural, Consumer, and Environmental Sciences (ACES), College of Applied Health Sciences (AHS), College of Business (BUS), College of Education (COE), College of Engineering (ENG), College of Fine and Applied Arts (FAA), and College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS). Note, 4 people were non-degree or had no college affiliation.



Major

There were a total of 45 primary majors reported, in addition to secondary majors, concentrations and minors. Numbers are generalized to protect student identity.
