Medicine and Public Health in Beijing Summer Program

- No other program like it at Illinois
- Host institution is Peking University Health Science Center
- 4 Weeks in Beijing (roughly end of May to end of June 2009)
- Summer of FR, SO or JR year
- Classes in Traditional Chinese Medicine, Public Health, Chinese Language and Culture
- Total of 6 credits return to Illinois [MCB 2xx (2 hr), EALC 199 (4 hr)]
- Opportunity for clinical experience
- Exposure to a different system and theory of Medical Practice
- Not just for Pre-Med students, Pre-Health Professional as well
- Advanced Credit Required for MCB Honours Concentration

MCB 2xx = Traditional Chinese Medicine and Public Health (2 credit hours)

EALC 199 = Chinese Language and Culture (3 credit hours)

Requires 8 week course at UIUC prior to departure (1 credit hour)

Cost of Program = \$4,500-\$5,000
